




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SeamVision Step-By-Step Install with Pictures

Cable Path Example






































Machine Connections


1. Put in control relay SV711 for T300 OR SV707 for T600






2. Wire in any 1D1 to terminal A1+ and terminal 11.














3. Find wire 4351 on the relay and attach blue wire.



4. 4351 wire goes to A2 - of the relay previously installed.



5. Remove white rubber from stripped wire assembly.




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6. White wire from 8 conductor cable goes to the previously added relay on terminal 14.




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7. The brown wire of the 8 conductor cable goes to any 1D1.




8. The greem wire of the 8 conductor cable goes to ground.








9. The yellow wire of the 8 conductor cable goes to #5 of the #7 conductor cable.




10. The gray with of the 8 conductor cable gets capped off.




11. The pink wire of the 8 conductor cable goes to #2 of the #7 conductor cable.

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
10. The blue with of the 8 conductor cable goes to any 1D0.









13. The red wire of the 8 conductor cable goes to #3 of the #7 conductor cable.



14. The green wire of the 7 conductor cable goes to ground.





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
15. #1 of the 7 conductor wire goes to any 1D0.

Stack Light Connections


17. Strip 7 conductor cable.



18. #1 connects to white of the stack light.








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
18. #3 connects to the red of the stack light.








21. #4 connects to the yellow wire of the stack light.
